

# COUNCIL ON TEACHER EDUCATION

## P-12 School Representatives Reports/Updates

Shannon Nolte reported that the new Missouri Learning Standards are out and open for comment. Professional Development is focusing on the Student Learning Objectives. Heidi Beatty reported that they have agriculture students currently making presentations in their classrooms for Agriculture on the Move.

Ms. Veasey moved to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2015, meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Pival and unanimously approved.

Dr. Zeliff moved, seconded by Dr. Christensen, to approve the agenda. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Pival moved, seconded by Dr. Wall, to approve Proposal 115-61-03, M.S.Ed. in Teacher Leader. Dr. Seeger provided background and information on the Teacher Leader program and how it relates to National Board Certification. Dr. Pival called for the question, and the motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Wall moved, seconded by Ms. Baker, to approve Proposal 115-08-02, Change in Course Number, Educational Psychology, change from 08-303 to 08-299. This course is used as a General Education requirement, and it has been requested to change the course number to align with other General Education courses. The motion carried with nine in the affirmative and one abstention.


## Director of Teacher Education Report

Dr. Pival reported that we had attended the MACTE Fall conference. Most of the discussion involved the MoPTA and getting candidates certified. They also talked about IHE's designing a bridge program to support students in our Education programs. The faculty at Northwest presented our new program design, and it was very well received. There was discussion about the concentrations in Elementary Education.

Dr. Malm announced that Dr. Doug Smith will be coming to campus on Monday, November 16, to demonstrate his innovative diagnostic-prescriptive process. This would be a

program that would possible help us meet the CAEP standard for impact on student learning. Sessions are set up from 9:00-11:00 for the presentation on the system in Administration Building 310. He will be meeting with the leadership session from 11:00-1:00. There will also be an abbreviated session from 1:00-2:00. We are also being asked to pilot some of this information.
