The meeting was called to order by Sarah Creason, Chairperson, with the following members present: Ashley Black, Dan Gordon, Greg Haddock, Joseph Haughey, Rob Voss for Joe Kreizinger, Jackie Lacy, Cheryl Malm, Mike McBride, Taylor Miles, Shannon Nolte, Greg Rich, Linda Smith (arrived during Agenda Item #5), Tim Wall, and Amy Wilson. The following members were absent: Shantel Farnan, School of Education; Andrea Mason, Horace Mann/Leet Center; Neil Nuttall, Ex Officio for Northwest-Kansas City; Destiny Plair, Undergraduate Student; and Rena Smith, College of Arts and Sciences. Terry Long and Nancy Zeliff were also present.

P-12 School Representatives Reports/Updates

Shannon Nolte reported that school districts have received their annual performance reports. Superintendents are working on the MSIP6 process. His school wants to applaud our efforts to have our candidates in the schools. This has been a positive experience in his schools, and other superintendents have expressed that they have had those same experiences.

Dr. Rich moved to approve the minutes of the October 12, 2017, meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Voss and unanimously approved.

Dr. Voss moved, seconded by Dr. Wall, to approve the agenda. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Wall moved, seconded by Ms. Lacy, to approve Proposal 117-44-09, Change in Middle School Certification, Business Education 5-9. Nancy Zeliff indicated that these changes are proposed to align with the DESE certification requirements. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Gordon moved, seconded by Dr. Rich approve Proposal 117-22-04, Change in M.S.Ed. in Physical Education. Dr. Long explained that this program was designed to enhance the program to make it more relevant. The program will be completed online. With the justification that Dr. Long provided, the motion was amended that the proposal needs to have a justification prior to being sent on. Dr. Gordon and Dr. Rich agreed with this amendment. The amended motion was approved with one abstention.

Dr. Smith moved, seconded by Dr. Gordon, to approve Proposal 117-10-07, Change in Minor, English. Ashley Black explained that changes were made to the minor to align with DESE certification requirements. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Wall moved, secondary by Dr. Gordon, to approve Proposal 117-13-01, Deletion of Minor, Elementary Art Education and Proposal 117-13-02, Deletion of Minor, Secondary Art Education. The certificates aligned with these minors are no longer available and do not lead to certification. The motion was unanimously approved.

Director of Teacher Education Report

Dr. Wall stated that we have increased our enrollment in education programs. The enrollment in the new Online Professional master's programs has contributed to this growth. He attended the MACTE fall meeting where the new director of DESE Educator Quality, Suzanne Hull, addressed those present. She is a strong advocate for our education programs. He also attended the CAEP conference and more information will be shared about the CAEP standards at our next meeting.

Dr. Gordon moved to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Rich and unanimously approved.
