

COUNCIL ON TEACHER EDUCATION

Thursday, February 11, 2016

The meeting was called to order by Joseph Haughey, Chairperson, with the following members present: Jill Baker, Summer Christensen, Cheryl Malm, Michael McBride (left during Agenda Items 6-10), Gina McNeese, Joyce Pivaler (left during Agenda Items 6-10 with voting privilege moved to Dr. Malm), Stuart Robinson, Michele Veasey, Robert Voss, Jennifer Wall (left following Agenda Item 11), Tim Wall, Tessa White (left during Agenda Items 6-10), and Nancy Zeliff. The following members were absent: Leslie Galbreath, Ex Officio for Owens Library; Greg Haddock, Ex Officio for Graduate School; Baylee Scarbrough, Undergraduate Student. Public school representatives Heidi Beatty, Tricia Knowles, and Shannon Nolte were unable to attend. Shantel Farnan, Pradnya Patet, Nancy Foley, Pat Thompson, Sue Wood, and Taylor Blevins (student teacher for Heidi Beatty) were also present.

P-12 School Representatives Reports/Updates

Taylor Blevins, Heidi Beatty's student teacher, provided a statement prepared by Ms. Beatty.

Ms. Baker moved to approve the minutes of the January 14, 2016, meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Tim Wall and unanimously approved.

Dr. Pivaler moved, seconded by Dr. Christensen, to approve the agenda. The motion was unanimously approved.

Ms. Baker moved, seconded by Dr. Pivaler, to approve Proposal 216-61-01, Action Research Paper (61-683). Dr. Tim Wall explained that the purpose of this proposal was to incentivize timely completion and provide library access. Following discussion, a friendly amendment was proposed to change the language of "successful completion" to "successful," change the credit from 1 credit to variable 1-3 credits, and make effective Fall 2016. Ms. Baker and Dr. Pivaler accepted the friendly amendment. The motion carried with one abstention.

Dr. Voss moved, seconded by Dr. Pivaler, to approve Proposal 216-61-02, Field Study in Administration and Supervision (61-724). Following discussion, a friendly amendment was proposed to change the language of "successful completion" to "successful," make effective Fall 2016, and include on the master course file "Changed from 2-6 hours to 1-6 hours." Dr. Voss and Dr. Pivaler accepted the friendly amendment. The motion carried with one abstention.

Dr. Jenni Wall moved, seconded by Ms. Baker, to bundle the Proposals 216-62-04, 216-62-05, 216-62-06, 216-62-07, 216-62-08. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Jenni Wall moved, seconded by Ms. Baker, to approve the following proposals with the presented edits.

- Proposal 216-62-04, Change in Major, Elementary Education
- Proposal 216-62-05, Change in Major, Special Education
- Proposal 216-62-06, Change in Major, Middle School Education
- Proposal 216-62-07, Change in Major, Secondary Education
- Proposal 216-62-08, Change in Major, Elementary/Secondary Education

Information was presented on these proposals that included a PowerPoint. Drafts of four-year plans were also provided to illustrate these programs. Dr. Haughey called for the question and the motion carried with one opposed.

Dr. Tim Wall moved, seconded by Ms. Baker, to approve Proposal 216-62-09, Approval of New Major, Early Childhood Education with add-on Early Childhood Education with add-on Early Childhood Special Education. Dr. Patet provide a description of the proposed new major. A friendly amendment was proposed to approve this proposal with the presented edits. Dr. Tim Wall and Ms. Baker accepted the friendly amendment. The motion carried with one opposed.

Dr. Malm moved, seconded by Ms. Baker, to approve the revision of the Council on Teacher Education By-laws as proposed. Dr. Haughey explained the changes that were proposed. A friendly amendment was proposed to make the by-laws effective for the election in April. Dr. Malm and Ms. Baker accepted the friendly amendment. The motion to approve the revision to the by-laws was unanimously approved.

The meeting was adjourned.
