- ☐ Submit private scholarship information in CatPAWS and send check(s) to the Office of Scholarships and Financial Assistance.
- ☐ Request final high school and college transcripts be sent to Northwest by recommended date of June 30.
- □ Attend Summer Orientation, Advisement, and Registration (SOAR) or Transfer and Returning Student Orientation this Spring or Summer. Sign up begins Feb. 16 for Fall 2026 students.
