



# The Art of Healing Galleries at Mosaic Medical Center - Maryville in partnership with Northwest Missouri State University

#### JURIED EXHIBITION DETAILS

Mosaic Medical Center-Maryville and Northwest Missouri State University's Department of Fine & Performing Arts invite artists **who reside within 100 miles of Maryville, MO**, to participate in the inaugural juried exhibition at the *Art of Healing Galleries* located in Mosaic Medical Center-Maryville. The *Art of Healing Galleries* are an exciting, new collaborative partnership between Mosaic Medical Center-Maryville and Northwest Missouri State University to integrate the power of art with medicine.

Qualified artists selected for participation in the Exhibition shall have their artwork displayed at the *Art of Healing Galleries* beginning in April 2022 for approximately six months thereafter unless artwork is sold.

The theme for the April 2022 Exhibition is: Artist's Choice

Each artist may submit up to three (3) works. There is no entry fee.

### **SUMMARY OF ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible, each entry must include the following requirements:

- Signed Entry Form (if participant is under the age of 18, entry form must be signed by parent or legal guardian)
- A photo of each entered work (refer to section below)

Entries must include a photo of the artwork. Please include a photograph of each work separately, if entering more than one piece. Please avoid distracting backgrounds. Digital photo files must be in .jpg format and no larger than 1MB. Each file must be named with artist's name, entry number, title, medium, year of creation (for example: Conway\_ Entry 1\_Spirit of Missouri\_oiloncanvas\_2010.jpg).

All entries must be received by11:59 PM, March 4, 2022.

All entries must be original and the sole property of the artist for show or sale and may not contain copyrighted materials owned by others (including photographs, sculptures, paintings, or other works of art or images) without the express written permission of the copyright holder. Artwork in most media will be considered; however, due to the limitations

of the venue, video and performance art cannot be accommodated.

There is no maximum size for submitted entries. We have a few exhibition areas for extremely large works to be displayed on walls or suspended from the ceiling, and would be delighted to consider them for exhibition.

Please no sawtooth hangers, slot hangers or glass with clips. Art must be framed in a standard frame with wire on the back, ready for hanging. Canvases are not required to be framed if the canvas is wrapped around the edges, but still must have a wire for hanging.

Works on paper must be matted, framed under glass and not plexiglass.

All Selected Artwork **must** be labeled on the reverse (wall mounted) or bottom (sculpture/pottery) with the artist's name, title, medium, price and contact information.

Price: \$100 (or please use "NFS" if your piece is not for sale)

All Selected Artwork must arrive appropriately framed and/or mounted and ready for presentation or hanging. Two-dimensional work must be ready to hang with appropriate hardware and wiring installed.

### ARTIST PROCEEDS

- Artists will include asking price for artwork displayed when submitting for review.
- Prices will be included on an informational tag placed on the wall or in the case next to each piece.
- All sales will take place through an online portal. Once the sale is final, 75% of the proceeds will be sent to the artist via PayPal.
- By participating in the Art of Healing Galleries, artist agrees that 25% of stated purchase price will be donated back to the MMC-M Art of Healing Galleries Fund to further support and develop art initiatives at MMC-M.
