

FRESHMAN PLAY AUDITIONS!

The first play produced this year by the Northwest Theatre program will be the 28th annual Freshman/Transfer Showcase, a mainstage play especially for first year students! The name of this year's play is "LOVE/SICK, by John Cariani.

AUDITIONS will be held the first week of classes on Tuesday, August 28, 6 p.m. in the Ron Houston Center for the Performing Arts (tall, white building west of the football field).
