Who can submit a poster?

Any student or group of students who has completed a project or research in a field related to therapeutic recreation. All poster submissions will be accepted unless the content is deemed inappropriate by the conference committee.

What are the benefits to participating?

Receive feedback from experienced professionals in the industry

Disseminate your hard work

What should be included on my poster?

- Your poster will need to either be on an easel or table for viewing. You will need to provide the easel. If you need a table, your poster needs to be able to stand on its own. We can provide a table for you at the Symposium, but you may be required to share the table with another student.
- Posters should be no larger than 3' x 4'. The poster should be easy to read and include a logical flow of your project or research (summary/intro, methodology, findings, & conclusion).
- Pictures, diagrams, charts and other visual aids are encouraged.
- Remember to add your name(s) and your school name somewhere on your poster.
