- PATHOGENS
 - DISEASE CAUSING AGENTS
- AUTOINOCULATION
 - TRANSMISSION FROM ONE PART OF YOUR BODY TO ANOTHER
- TOXINS
 - POISONOUS SUBSTANCES
- MULTIFACTORAL
 - INTERACTION OF SEVERAL FACTORS



TRANSMISSSION OF DISEASE

- CHAIN OF INFECTION
- CAUSATIVE AGENT, SOURCE
- EXIT, TRANSMISSION
- ENTRY, NEW HOST
- DIRECT TRANSMISSION
 - BETWEEN INFECTED PERSONS
- INDIRECT TRANSMISSION
 - CONTACTING OBJECT OF INFECTED PERSON



THE BODY'S DEFENSE

- SECRETIONS: TEARS, MUCOUS, SWEAT
- MUCOUS MEMBRANES: TRAP INVADERS, CILIA
- · ENZYME & BLOOD CAUSES INVADERS TO BURST
- · IMMUNE SYSTEM
 - ANTIGEN/ANTIBODY RESPONSE
 - WHITE BLOOD CELLS
 - MACROPHAGES, PHAGOCYTES
 - · LYMPHOCYTES: T-CELLS, B-CELLS
- INTERFERON: PROTECTIVE PROTEINS



BACTERIA

- · SEVERAL THOUSAND
- · 100 CAUSE DISEASE
- · TOXINS
- ON SKIN AT ALL TIMES
- · STAPHYLOCOCCAL...
- RESISTANT HOSPITAL STRAINS
- STREPTOCOCCAL_S
 - STREP THROAT, SCARLET & RHEUMATIC
- PNEUMONIA, TUBERCULOSIS, PERIODONTAL



VIRUSES

- SMALLEST PATHOGEN...150 KNOWN
- · ATTACH TO HOST CELL
- · COMMON COLD:
 - 100 DIFFERENT ONES
- · INFLUENZA: A-B-C
- MONONUCLEOSIS: EPSTEIN-BARR
- · HEPATITIS:
 - INFLAMMATION OF LIVER
 - A-INFECTIOUS, B-SERUM, NON A, NON B & D
 - MORE INDIVIDUALS AT RISK THAN HIV



TRANSMISSION OF STD'S

- INTIMATE SEXUAL CONTACT
 - INTERCOURSE, ORAL-GENITAL, HAND-GENITAL, ANAL
- RARELY BY MOUTH-TO-MOUTH OR CONTACT WITH FLUIDS FROM SORES
- STD TRANSMISSION
 - DARK, MOIST PLACES...MUCOUS MEMBRANES IN REPRODUCTIVE ORGANS
- PATHOGENS SENSITIVE TO
 - LIGHT, EXCESS HEAT, COLD, DRYNESS

MALES CHLAMYDIA FEMALES

PAIN IN URINATION, WATERY, PUSLIKE DISCHARGE

DISCHARGE, SPOTTING., OR NO SYMPTOMS

SECONDARY INFECTIONS REPRODUCTIVE, ARTHRITIS, HEART, DISEASES.

BLOCKS FALLOPIAN TUBES, STERILITY 10%+ OF ALL COLLEGE

5 x AS MANY AS GONORRHEA STUDENTS MOST COMMON IN WHITE

HETEROSEXUALS

PELVIC INFLAMMATORY DISEASE (PID)

- · UTERUS, FALLOPIAN TUBES, AND OVARIES
- · UNTREATED STD'S
- · SYMPTOMS:
 - INFLAMMATION PAIN MENSTRUAL
 - FEVER NAUSEA, PAINFUL INTERCOURSE
- RISK FACTORS
 - AGE OF 1ST INTERCOURSE
 - MULTIPLE SEXUAL PARTNERS
- · LONG-TERM CONSEQUENCES
 - TUBAL PREGNANCIES INFERTILITY



GONORRHEA

- BACTERIA INFECTS LININGS OF URETHRA. GENITAL TRACT, PHARYNX, RECTUM
- - DISCHARGE PAIN & BURNING
- 20% EXPERIENCE THE SYMPTOMS...
- CONTROLLED BY ANTIBIOTICS
 - ANTIBIOTIC RESISTANT



SYPHILIS

- PRIMARY SYPHILIS.
 - CHANCRE (3-4 WEEKS AFTER)
- DISAPPEAR IN 3-6 WEEKS
- → SECONDARY SYPHILIS...
- RASH/WHITE PATCHES ON MOUTH, THROAT, GENITALS
- LATENT SYPHILIS...
- NO SYMPTOMS RARELY TRANSMITTED
- **→LATE SYPHILIS...**
 - YEARS LATER, HEART, SENSES, SENILITY



GENITAL WARTS

- ⇔HUMAN PAPILLOMA VIRUSES (HPV)...
 - PENETRATION OF SKIN OR MUCOUS LINING OF GENITALIANAL LININGS (6-8 WEEKS)
- MANY HAVE NO SYMPTOMS
 - PROTRUDING OR FLAT WARTS
- MAY DISAPPEAR ON OWN OR GROW
- UNTREATED: DYSPLASIA (PRECANCEROUS) CONDITION)



HERPES

- BURNING SENSATION AT SITE OF ENTRY
- BLISTER CONTAINING VIRUS
- BLISTER DISAPPEARS
 - VIRUS TO BASE OF NERVE & LIES DORMANT
- SUSCEPTIBILITY
 - STRESS, DIET, IMMUNE SYSTEM, SUNLIGHT
- TREATMENT
 - ACYCLOVIR
- RISKS & CONSEQUENCES
 - CANCER, CEASAREAN DELIVERIES
- · SAME VIRUS ON MOUTH OR GENITALS

ACQUIRED IMMUNE DEFICIENCY SYNDROME

- HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS
- MULTIPLE PARDONERS, UNPROTECTED SEX AND SHARING OF IV NEEDLES
- REPORTING HIV
 - 20 STATES REQ.
 - 12 REQ. ANONYMOUS
- 18 DO NOT REQ. ANY
- ELISHA & WESTERN BLOT



TRANSMISSION OF HIV

- · BODY FLUIDS SHARING NEEDLE
- · ENTRY: GENITALS-ANUS (MUCOUS MEMBRANES)
- · VIRUS INVADES BLOOD & SPINAL FLUID
 - KILLS HELPER T-LYMPHOCYTES
 - DECREASES IMMUNITY
- NUMBER OF EXPOSURES
- MOTHER TO CHILD UTERUS OR BIRTH CANAL
- NOT HIGHLY CONTAGIOUS



ALLERGY

- BODY PRODUCES ANTIBODIES IN RESPONSE TO
- ANTIGENS (DUST, POLLEN, ETC
- ANTIBODIES TRIGGER HISTAMINE
- -- DILATES BLOOD VESSELS, INCREASES
 MUCOUS & SWELLING
- 4 HAYFEVER, ALLERGIC RHINITIS, ASTHMA
- 4 AGE, STRESS LEVEL ARE FACTORS
- TREATMENTS: AVOIDANCE, ANTIHISTAMINE, SHOTS



HEADACHES

- TENSION HEADACHES...
 - TENSION IN NECK AREA OR HEAD. TX:
- MIGRAINE HEADACHES...(20% OF US)
 - ONE SIDE OF HEAD.
 - DILATION/CONSTRICTION OF BLOOD VESSELS
- SECONDARY...
 - SINUS, ALLERGIES, LOW BLOOD SUGAR,
 - ANXIETY, DEPRESSION, EMOTIONAL
- RELAXATION & VARIOUS DRUGS TO TREAT



SEIZURE DISORDERS

- EPILEPSY : ABNORMAL ELECTRICAL ACTIVITY IN BRAIN
- · GRAND MAL: CONVULSIONS
- PETIT MAL: MINOR LOSS OF CONSCIOUSNESS
- PSYCHOMOTOR: REPETITIVE MOVEMENTS.
- JACSONIAN SEIZURE: 1 PART OF BODY TO ANOTHER.
- MEDICATION: ANTICONVULSANT & SURGERY



FEMALE DISORDERS

- FIBROCYSTIC BREAST CONDITION
 - HORMONAL , INHERITED, DIET
- FLUID-FILLED OR FIBROUS (DRAIN/REMOVE)
- **ENDOMETRIOSIS**
- AGES 20-40 ABNORMAL GROWTH OF ENDOMETRIAL TISSUE (IN UTERUS)
- IRREGULAR PERIODS & FLOW-PAIN
- PMS
 - 7-10 DAYS BEFORE PERIOD
 - HORMONAL, STRESS



DIABETES

- · INSUFFICIENT INSULIN
 - THIRST, URINATION, HUNGER, FATIGUE, SLOW HEALING, NUMBNESS/TINGLING, ETC.
- 15 MILLION (1/2 UNAWARE)
 - . IMPAIRED BLOOD CIRCULATION
 - BLINDNESS, STROKE, KIDNEY PROBLEMS, LOSS OF LIMBS, SEVERE INFECTIONS
 - · TYPE 1: INSULIN DEPENDENT- EARLY IN LIFE,
 - TYPE 2: INSULIN PRODUCTION IS DEFICIENT
 - ADULT ONSET
 - LIFESTYLE



MISCELLANEOUS

- · PEPTIC ULCER
 - STOMACH OR INTESTINE
 - STRESS, BACTERIA
- · LOW BACK PAIN
 - 80% WILL DEVELOP
 - MAJOR CAUSE OF DISABILITY FOR AGES 20-45
 - MORE LOST WORK TIME THAN ANY OTHER
 - · EXCEPT UPPER RESPIRATORY INFECTIONS
 - OVER \$18 BILLION YEARLY
 - STRENGTH & FITNESS PREVENT
 - STRESS, OCCUPATION, POSTURE CAUSE



CANDIDIASIS

- YEAST FUNGUS OF VAGINAL TRACT
 - BIRTH CONTROL PILLS, ANTIBIOTICS,
 - · VAGINA LESS ACIDIC.
- SYMPTOMS
 - VAGINAL ITCHING, BURNING, VAGINITIS
 - WHITE CHEESY DISCHARGE
- · TX: ANTIFUNGAL DRUGS...
- AGGRAVATED BY
 - SOAPS, CHLORINATED WATER, SPERMICIDES, TIGHT FITTING JEANS, PANTY HOSE



PUBIC LICE

- SMALL PARASITES
- USUALLY DURING SEXUAL CONTACT, ATTACH TO PUBIC HAIR
- WASH CLOTHING, FURNITURE, LINENS
- 2-3 WEEKS TO KILL LARVAL FORMS
- CAN GET LICE ON INFECTED SHEETS
