**Dear Horace Mann and Leet Center Families,**

We are excited to kick off the annual Horace Mann STEM-A-THON. When choosing a fundraiser, the Parent Advisory Council fundraising committee members felt it was important to choose an event that 1) did not involve door to door sales, 2) engaged our children, and 3) involved the Northwest community. The **STEM-A-THON** accomplishes these goals.

1. Families provide the names of 5-10 family/friends who will receive letters about Horace Mann and if they would like to contribute, provides details on how to do so.
2. All students will be actively participating in STEM activities throughout the day
3. Computer and Information Technology, Science, and Math departments will provide activities as well as MAD SCIENCE OF KANSAS CITY for grades K-6.

Horace Mann is a tuition assisted school which means tuition assists but does not cover all operating expenses. Funds raised through the **STEM-A-THON** will assist in providing the best possible environment for our children with highly engaging materials and experiences. We have smaller fundraisers throughout the year such as stadium trash pick-up, Taco Johns, popcorn Fridays, and T-shirt sales that assist with field trip expenses.

The **STEM-A-THON** is an event that will take place at Horace Mann on **April 12 from 9:00 am-3:00 pm**. Our children will participate in activities and events focused on engaging, hands-on science, technology, engineering, math, and the arts. The activities and events will be provided by Northwest students in various departments, schools, organizations, and student groups. Sponsors can donate an amount for the child's participation in the event. Donations can be made via check or online.

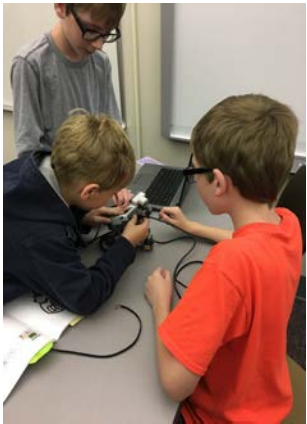
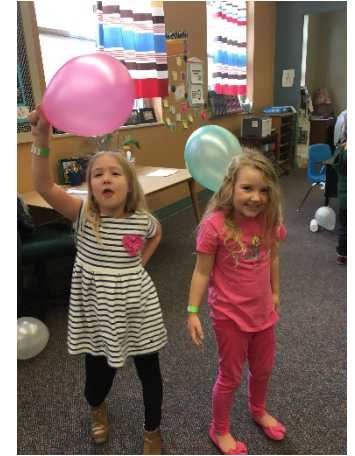

## How it Works
