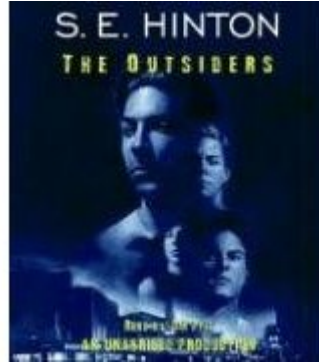


ENGLISH 590: YOUNG ADULT LITERATURE
