### **Purpose**

The University is committed to maintaining a safe and accessible campus for students, employees, visitors, and emergency personnel.

### **Policy**

Vehicles may be towed or immobilized while on University property for the following reasons:

- Parking on campus after a permit has been revoked
- Accumulation of 12 or more violations per vehicle within the permit year
- Blocking fire lanes or fire hydrants
- Obstruction of pedestrian or traffic lanes or creating a hazard
- Abandoned vehicle
- Blocking loading zones
- Blocking or impeding snow removal
- Parking in a handicap designated area
- Parking in a reserved or blocked off area
- Not displaying proper campus registration
- When University Police personnel deem towing or immobilization necessary for safety, security or any campus operation.
