(Response to Intervention/Pyramid of Instruction)

Target Audience: K-12 teachers, all content areas, administrators

Intended Outcomes:

- Develop an understanding of the tiered process of RtI
- School-wide consistency in structures at differentiated levels of learning

- Using an implementation rubric, the following components will be reviewed:
 - Current use of benchmarks and common assessments
 - Current use of instructional time for tiers or reteaching
- Teacher survey of current instructional and grading practices
