Staff Council Scholarship – Shelby

• \$571.68 contributed to the fund since July 1st (one bake sale and payroll contributions)

- Over 30 applicants for the scholarship. Committee must make a decision by March 1st. Committee will validate that the applicants are eligible. Financial need is leading factor for award.
- In the past, they have selected two people. We can award \$1,300 total this year.

- We would like to align with faculty senate and have the new council begin in August. This allows the current council to finish the fiscal/academic year and ELT/strategic planning. Over the summer, the council would include "old" and "new" members. Can employees stay on the same committee for their entire term for continuity of knowledge? Can at least the committee chairs stay on the same committee unless they move to the executive committee?
- Designated alternates
 - o Current policy if you cannot attend, just send someone in your place.
 - o Should we have an official alternate? Yes, the person with the next most votes to be on the council can be an official alternate if the council member cannot attend.
